Hike at Los Gatos Creek Trail



Los Gatos Creek Trail south of downtown

Second Saturday of the month @ 9:45 am

Walk up the Los Gatos Creek Trail toward St. Joseph's Hill Open Space in Los Gatos. Meet in front of the Purple Onion café, 26 E Main St, Los Gatos, CA 95030, which is near the trailhead. Parking can be found in public lots along University and Santa Cruz Aves. The exercise level of this walk is "ambitious" and takes about 90 minutes round trip. You'll see wonderful vistas of Los Gatos Creek and Lexington Reservoir along the way. After the hike there is the option of coffee or tea at one of the cafés near the trailhead on Main St in Los Gatos.

Directions to Purple Onion Café:

From US-101 or I-280 or CA-85, take I-880/CA-17 exit and travel south to Exit #20A (East Los Gatos) onto CA-9 (Los Gatos/Saratoga Rd) eastbound. Turn right onto Los Gatos Blvd which turns into Main St. Lot #5 off Main Street just before Santa Cruz has 3 hours free parking.
