Annulment Talk



Any kind of *Transition* can be an arduous task, but at the beginning of the *new* phase, beauty and peace and joy emerge. One particularly arduous task of making the transition from couple-hood to single-hood is the question of **Annulment**. Is it necessary? What about my kids? How do I decide?

Father George Aranha, our Pastor, will treat this topic at the *September 17, 2008 Transitions* meeting. He will talk about the **Annulment** process: what it involves, how to initiate it, what it costs. He will also address the spiritual and emotional stages one goes through.

Transitions is a drop-in support group that meets on the first and third Wednesdays of every month. If you or someone you know has suffered the breakup of a marriage or significant relationship, this group might be helpful. The regular meetings are informal and unstructured, confidential and safe. From time to time we have special guest speakers on a topic of interest, as we do this time.
